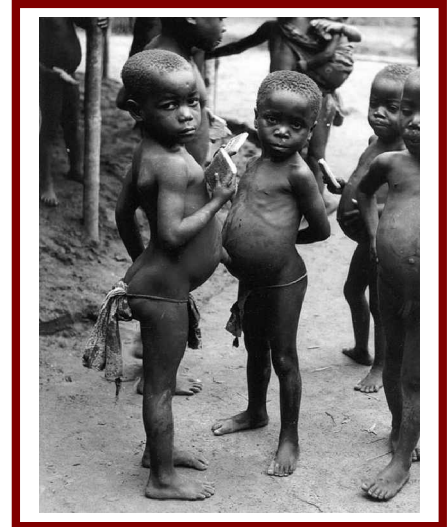
Water-borne diseases kill at least 3.4 million people every year.

This according to Jamie Bartram, Coordinator of the WHO's Water, Sanitation and Health Program. "This is a big health problem and the people who are really suffering are the poor in developing countries, especially children."

"That has a tremendous impact on mortality and living standards," said Robert Fraser who coordinates water and sanitation efforts in East Africa for the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC).
